Direpresentasikannya kembali Tionghoa dalam buku teks pelajaran sejarah bukan semata-mata masalah konten, namun terdapat nilai (value) yang hendak dikonstruksi di dalamnya. Untuk itu, konstruksi kebinekaan dari narasi-narasi tentang Tionghoa dalam buku teks menjadi amat penting. Dengan metode Critical Discourse Analysis (CDA), buku ini membongkar representasi Tionghoa dalam buku teks Sejarah Indonesia menurut Kurikulum 2013 yang diterbitkan oleh negara. Pada dimensi teks, Tionghoa direpresentasikan sebagai bagian dari Sejarah Nasional Indonesia yang koheren dan utuh (global coherence), namun masih berpotensi terjebak pada formalitas dan tenggelam pada kedangkalan makna karena terlanjur membekukan ideologi tertentu dalam mempersepsikan Tionghoa. Dimensi kognisi sosial diwarnai pergulatan proses mental yang dibentuk oleh memori kolektif Orde Baru dengan kebaruan yang diusung Reformasi dalam produksi teks tentang Tionghoa. Dimensi konteks sosial memperlihatkan relasi kuasa Orde Baru dan citra negatif terhadap Tionghoa yang belum sepenuhnya hilang telah memberi kerangka

bagi kognisi sosial masyarakat. Pada akhirnya, buku ini hendak menggerakkan kesadaran perlunya bentuk ideal dalam mengakomodasi kenyataan kebinekaan melalui pendidikan sejarah yang inklusif. Upaya ini tidak hanya terkait dengan penulisan buku teks, namun membuka rekomendasi bagi guru sejarah bahwa upaya mewujudkan pendidikan sejarah yang inklusif di kelas tidak boleh hanya mengandalkan buku teks belaka. Ketersediaan sumber belajar yang sangat berlimpah, termasuk kearifan lokal setempat bahkan pengalaman hidup siswa, dapat dimanfaatkan sebagai bahan ajar yang memberi ruang pada peran Tionghoa maupun kelompok masyarakat lain dalam mengonstruksi sejarah nasional. Penulis memilih hukum pidana sebagai fokus utama dalam buku ini, karena sedikit sekali penelitian-penelitian yang membahas tentang sejarah hukum pidana. Sejarah berlakunya Hukum perdata Islam seperti hukum

pernikahan, hukum waris, hukum zakat, hukum wakaf, dan hukum ekonomi Islam pada zaman kerajaan-kerajaan sebelum kemerdekaan telah diakui eksistensinya, dan berlaku sampai sekarang. Namun sejarah berlakunya hukum pidana Islam di Kerajaan-kerajaan Islam masih diperdebatkan dan tidak diberlakukan di Indonesia. Hukum Islam merupakan salah satu komponen tata hukum Indonesia yang berkontestasi secara gradual untuk menjadi salah satu bahan baku pembentukan hukum nasional di antara pluralitas hukum yang ada di Indonesia. Bila dilihat secara historis, bahwa hukum Islam telah hidup dan diterapkan di masyarakat sejak Islam masuk ke nusantara. Berdasarkan situasi ini, Filsafat Nusantara lahir sebagai penjamin persatuan dan kesatuan bangsa; sebagai identitas bangsa Indonesia yang berasal dari otentisitas diri sendiri; dan sebagai falsafah kehidupan bagi bangsa Indonesia. Karena itu, Filsafat Nusantara adalah pemikiran yang lahir dari bangsa Indonesia, oleh bangsa Indonesia, dan untuk bangsa Indonesia.

From Citizens to Subjects challenges the common assertion in historiography that Enlightenment-era centralization and rationalization brought progress and prosperity to all European states, arguing instead that centralization failed to improve the socioeconomic position of urban residents in the former Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth over a hundred-year period. Murphy examines the government of the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth and the several imperial administrations that replaced it after the Partitions, comparing and contrasting their relationships with local citizenry, minority communities, and nobles who enjoyed considerable autonomy in their management of the cities of present-day Poland, Ukraine, and Belarus. He shows how the failure of Enlightenment-era reform was a direct

result of the inherent defects in the reformers' visions, rather than from sabotage by shortsighted local residents. Reform in Poland-Lithuania effectively destroyed the existing system of complexities and imprecisions that had allowed certain towns to flourish, while also fostering a culture of self-government and civic republicanism among city citizens of all ranks and religions. By the mid-nineteenth century, the increasingly immobile post-Enlightenment state had transformed activist citizens into largely powerless subjects without conferring the promised material and economic benefits of centralization.

Every year, the Bibliography catalogues the most important new publications, historiographical monographs, and journal articles throughout the world, extending from prehistory and ancient history to the most recent contemporary historical studies. Anguish, Anger, and Folkways in Soviet Russia offers original perspectives on the politics of everyday life in the Soviet Union by closely examining the coping mechanisms individuals and leaders alike developed as they grappled with the political, social, and intellectual challenges the system presented before and after World War II. As Gábor T. Rittersporn shows, the "little tactics" people employed in their daily lives not only helped them endure the rigors of life during the Stalin and post-Stalin periods but also strongly influenced the system's development into the Gorbachev and post-Soviet eras. For Rittersporn, citizens' conscious and unreflected actions at all levels of society defined a distinct Soviet universe. Terror, faith, disillusionment, evasion, folk customs, revolt, and confusion about regime goals and the individual's relation to them were all integral to the development of that universe and the culture it engendered. Through a meticulous reading of primary documents and materials uncovered in numerous archives located in Russia and Germany, Rittersporn identifies three related responses—anguish, anger, and folkways—to the pressures people in all walks of life encountered, and shows how these responses in turn altered the way the system operated. Rittersporn finds that the leadership generated widespread anguish by its inability to understand and correct the reasons for the system's persistent political and economic dysfunctions. Rather than locate the sources of these problems in their own presuppositions and administrative methods, leaders attributed them to omnipresent conspiracy and wrecking, which they tried to extirpate through terror. He shows how the unrelenting pursuit of enemies exacerbated systemic failures and contributed to administrative breakdowns and social dissatisfaction. Anger resulted as the populace reacted to the notable gap between the promise of a self-governing egalitarian society and the actual experience of daily existence under the heavy hand of the party-state. Those who had interiorized systemic values demanded a return to what they took for the original Bolshevik project, while others sought an outlet for their frustrations in destructive or self-destructive behavior. In reaction to the system's pressure, citizens instinctively developed strategies of noncompliance and accommodation. A detailed examination of these folkways enables Rittersporn to identify and describe the mechanisms and spaces intuitively created by officials and ordinary citizens to evade the regime's dictates or to find a *modus vivendi* with

them. Citizens and officials alike employed folkways to facilitate work, avoid tasks, advance careers, augment their incomes, display loyalty, enjoy life's pleasures, and simply to survive. Through his research, Rittersporn uncovers a fascinating world consisting of peasant stratagems and subterfuges, underground financial institutions, falsified Supreme Court documents, and associations devoted to peculiar sexual practices. As Rittersporn shows, popular and elite responses and tactics deepened the regime's ineffectiveness and set its modernization project off down unintended paths. Trapped in a web of behavioral patterns and social representations that eluded the understanding of both conservatives and reformers, the Soviet system entered a cycle of self-defeat where leaders and led exercised less and less control over the course of events. In the end, a new system emerged that neither the establishment nor the rest of society could foresee.

Civic and Ethnic Nationalism in East and West

It was the 50s and life was simple, until September 25, 1954. That was the night that would be etched in the memory of the citizens of Stanfield, Massachusetts. The author has researched court records, newspapers, interviewed neighbors, police and has drawn on personal recollections of the crime. The story has been recounted over and over and to this day, it continues to be discussed. *A Thread of Evidence* is a compelling account of superb detective work, and unprecedented dedication of an entire police department.

Russia And Eastern Europe After Communism

This book discusses the diverse practices and discourses of memory politics in Russia and Eastern Europe. It argues that currently prevailing conservatism has a long tradition, which continued even in Communist times, and is different to conservatism in the West, which can accommodate other viewpoints within liberal democratic systems. It considers how important history is for conservatism, and how history is reconstituted according to changing circumstances. Conservatism and Memory Politics in Russia and Eastern Europe

This volume presents work from an international group of writers who explore conceptualizations of what defined “East” and “West” in Eastern Europe, imperial Russia, and the Soviet Union. The contributors analyze the effects of transnational interactions on ideology, politics, and cultural production. They reveal that the roots of an East/West cultural divide were present many years prior to the rise of socialism and the Cold War.

The chapters offer insights into the complex stages of adoption and rejection of Western ideals in areas such as architecture, travel writings, film, music, health care, consumer products, political propaganda, and human rights. They describe a process of mental mapping whereby individuals “captured and possessed” Western identity through cultural encounters and developed their own interpretations from these experiences. Despite these imaginaries, political and intellectual elites devised responses of resistance, defiance, and counterattack to defy Western impositions.

Socialists believed that their cultural forms and collectivist strategies offered morally and materially better lives for the masses and the true path to a modern society. Their sentiments toward the West, however, fluctuated between superiority and inferiority. But in material terms, Western products, industry, and technology, became the ever-present yardstick by which progress was measured. The contributors conclude that the commodification of the necessities of modern life and the rise of consumerism in the twentieth century made it impossible for communist states to meet the demands of their citizens. The West eventually won the battle of supply and demand, and thus the battle for cultural influence.

East-European and Russian Studies in the American South

Russian and East European Studies

Heralded by Soviet propaganda as the "Path to the Future," the Baikal-Amur Mainline Railway (BAM) represented the hopes and dreams of Brezhnev and the Communist Party elite of the late Soviet era. Begun in 1974, and spanning approximately 2,000 miles after twenty-nine years of halting construction, the BAM project was intended to showcase the national unity, determination, skill, technology, and industrial might that Soviet socialism claimed to embody. More pragmatically, the Soviet leadership envisioned the BAM railway as a trade route to the Pacific, where markets for Soviet timber and petroleum would open up, and as an engine for the development of Siberia. Despite these aspirations and the massive commitment of economic resources on its behalf, BAM proved to be a boondoggle—a symbol of late communism's dysfunctionality—and a cruel joke to many ordinary Soviet citizens. In reality, BAM was woefully bereft of quality materials and construction, and victimized by poor planning and an inferior workforce. Today, the railway is fully complete, but remains a symbol of the profligate spending and inefficiency that characterized the Brezhnev years. In *Brezhnev's Folly*, Christopher J. Ward provides a groundbreaking social history of the BAM railway project. He examines the recruitment of hundreds of thousands of workers from the diverse republics of the USSR and other socialist countries, and his extensive archival research and interviews with numerous project workers provide an inside look at the daily life of the BAM workforce. We see firsthand the disorganization, empty promises, dire living and working conditions, environmental damage, and acts of crime, segregation, and discrimination that constituted daily life during the project's construction. Late Stalinist Russia

Focusing upon a region in Southern Bulgaria, a region that has been the crossroads between Europe and Asia for many centuries, this book describes how former Ottoman Empire Muslims were transformed into citizens of Balkan nation-states.
